SEARCHING tips

You will notice that Ebsco automatically looks for some variations – so if you type in colour, you get results containing color.

Typing in **innovat*** will find Innovator, Innovation, innovative and so on

Other refinements for finding more or related results:

Occasionally you will find extra items on your topic by asking for “equivalent” or “related”

Apply equivalent subjects

Apply related words

Useful for words that are mentioned in the article or text – however you may also find irrelevant results

Also search within the full text of the articles

SEARCHING tips cont'd

Refinements for finding a more focused result list:

Ensure you only find articles that exist in full on EBSCO by ticking Full text

Apply equivalent subjects

Apply related words

Also search within the full text

Look only for items in a certain date range

Limit your results

Publication Type

Selecting "Academic Journal" will restrict your search to publications such as *Harvard Business Review* and *Yale Law Journal*

Periodical includes publications such as *Fast Company* and *Forbes*



Email / saved results troubleshooting (taking an email as an example)



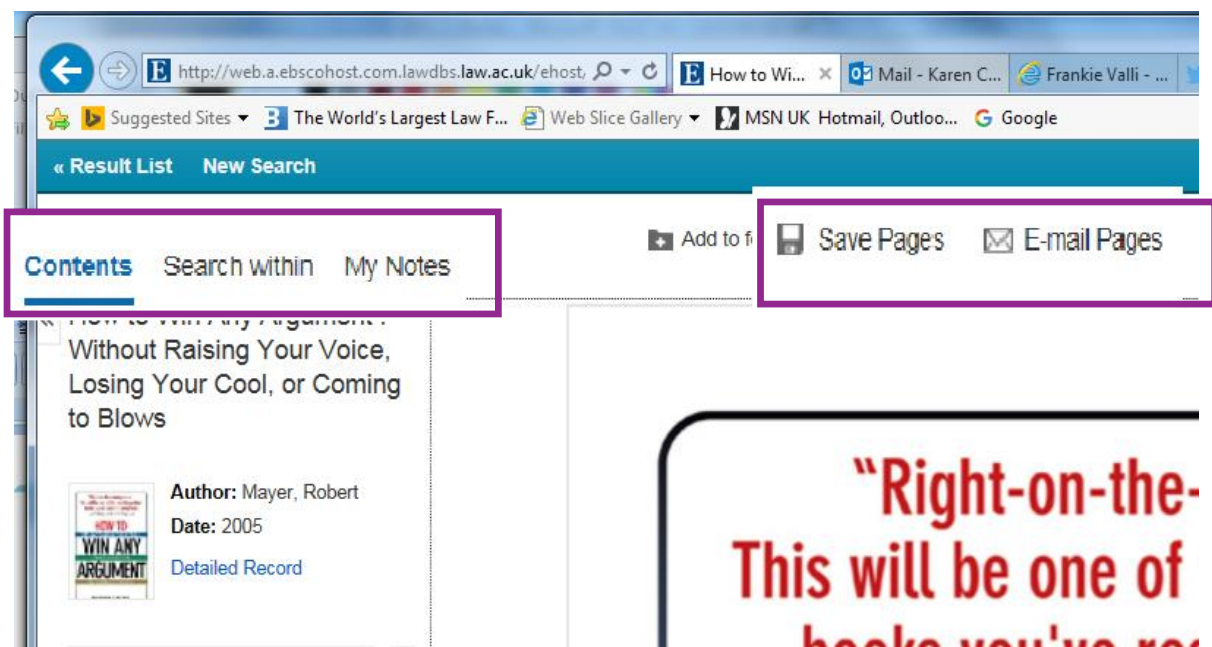
The email will help you collect bibliographic information which will be useful for referencing.

RESULTS – READING THE BOOK or ARTICLE

Click on  [PDF Full Text](#) or  [HTML Full Text](#) or  [EPUB Full Text](#) to read the book or article – if it doesn't load properly, you may need to start again with a different browser – Chrome and Firefox may work better than Internet Explorer – you need Javascript on your device for it to work properly.

You can email or save pages from the PDF as well as searching in the text
